

Vaccination Update

Vaccination information continues to change. Here is what we can tell you today:

Vaccine Availability

Skyline will continue to hold Vaccination Clinics in its downstairs meeting area Monday through Friday as vaccines are made available. We are maintaining a waiting list for those who qualify under [Phase 1B tier 1](#) of the Washington State's vaccination plan and who live in Klickitat County and Underwood, Wash. If you qualify and are within the designated demographic, call 509-493-1051. Please call and leave a message only once so our system is not overwhelmed.

As of today's posting, we are uncertain about the amount of vaccine we will receive next week. Please note: scheduling depends on actual doses received, so we ask everyone to be patient. In addition, we have yet to receive enough vaccine to hold a Drive-Through Clinic at Columbia High School; however, this remains a future option as the state releases additional vaccine and opens up phases.

Vaccine Tracker

As of today, Skyline has administered 996 Moderna vaccines with 945 people receiving the first dose and 51 people receiving the second dose. We have administered all vaccines received thus far. To keep up-to-date on vaccines being given by Skyline, visit www.myskylinehealth.org.
